The Passport to Leadership Program is designed to engage new members into the Jaycees. Members proceed through the program and earn the 10 total degrees. The program is designed to help them develop individual managerial and business skills in which they can use within and outside of the Jaycees.

I will highlight some of the steps within the various degrees: (Note, there are approximately 3-5 tasks per degree)

Involvement

- 1st Degree: Meet with 1 established/active member outside of a planned Jaycees function.
- 2nd Degree: Lead the Junior Chamber chapter in reciting the Jaycee Creed.
- 3rd Degree: Bring a prospective member to a chapter activity.

Experience

- 4th Degree: Chair a project and CPG must be provided.
- 5th Degree: Visit an activity of another chapter.
- 6th Degree: Attend a district, region, state, or national training session, forum, orientation, or meeting.

Leadership

- 7th Degree: Help a Jaycee advance one degree.
- 8th Degree: Create a fundraising project for your chapter or recruit a sponsor.
- 9th Degree: Serve in a state leadership position such as Program Manager, Regional Director, Vice President, etc.
- 10th Degree: Lead a State training.
